elie wiesel has given hundreds of interviews yet his fame as a human rights advocate often directs such conversations toward non literary issues indeed many of wiesel's questioners barely address the writer's role that has defined him since the 1950s unlike previous volumes in which he speaks with interviewers elie wiesel conversations collects interviews which set in relief the writer at work this book focuses on wiesel the literary artist instead of wiesel the holocaust survivor or the 1986 nobel peace prize laureate beyond highlighting wiesel's literary significance these interviews also correct many faulty assumptions about his achievement few american readers know that he writes in french that he has been favorably compared to andr malraux and albert camus not many realize that the holocaust has been the subject of only a few of his forty books particularly in his nonfiction wiesel's scope is wide addressing jewish life in all its religious and historical complexity though most of wiesel's books do not focus on the holocaust they are written against the backdrop of what he has come to term the event always the presence of auschwitz can be felt always the author lives in the shadows of the flames that once illuminated and blinded him these interviews are reminders that the writing life is both solitary and public interior and social the writer must venture beyond his study and speak out against the world's traumas and outrages robert franciosi is an associate professor of english at grand valley state university in allendale mich he is the editor of good morning a holocaust memoir his work has appeared in american poetry contemporary literature modern jewish studies and the william carlos williams review

the ransomed of god is the amazing true story of how one woman entered the shadowy world of international intrigue and breached the walls of a totalitarian regime in to help people escape from tyranny after the state of israel was formed in 1948 jews who remained in arab lands were in peril none more so than the 5000 jews of syria in the 1970s and 1980s their every move was closely monitored by the muhabaret the syrian security police extortion imprisonment and torture were a constant reality judy feld carr publicly championed the cause of syrian jews as she secretly negotiated their escape dealing with smugglers bribing officials haggling over travel documents arranging medical aid and funneling money to those in need even to those in prison the machinations involved diplomatic and intelligence official's at the highest levels the canadian american and israeli governments jewish organizations amnesty international and the international red cross judy feld carr had no previous connection to syria she grew up in sudbury ontario and was a music teacher in toronto her remarkable story stands as a testament to what one person can achieve when compassion is harnessed to determination

this book is a comparative analysis of power sharing agreements and peace processes in northern ireland and lebanon examining parallel journeys both societies took through power sharing to civil war returning to power sharing again it criticises and builds on the consociational democracy literature and takes an international perspective arguing that the external states with an interest in these ethno national conflicts largely determined the outcome of their power sharing accords it evaluates and contrasts the

imposition of power sharing as a means to regulate ethnic conflict in a democratic environment with a non democratic one what makes the book unique is its ability to compare for the first time in print the ethnic conflicts and power sharing agreements in both countries the sources used are based on exclusive access in the uk ireland and lebanon with over 125 interviews conducted for the book this timely publication brings the situation in both parts of the world up to date and evaluates the costs and benefits of external intervention in divided societies by regional or international powers
