in the material the real and the fractured self susan harrow explores the fascinating interrelation of subjectivity materiality and representation in the poetry and related texts of four modern french writers arthur rimbaud guillaume apollinaire francis ponge and jacques réda she demonstrates the richness and the relevance of modern french poetry for today s readers putting contemporary thought to work on the fractured self emerging in the post baudelairian lyric harrow addresses the widely perceived marginalization of poetry in the writing theory debate demonstrating that the emergence of a self at once shaped by and straining against material historical subjective and cultural impediments reveals fertile relations between theory and poetry where purer forms of postmodernist thinking have stressed the dissolution and dispersal of the human subject new approaches informed by

cultural studies autobiography theory and gender studies work to recover fictions of experience and retrieve submerged narratives of the self probing the activity of textual self recovery among the debris of history and fantasy visuality and desire and culture and corporeality the material the real and the fractured self imparts something of the startling beauty and the raw urgency of poetry writing across the broad modern period

during the last sixty to seventy years avant garde poetry in france has evolved in two directions one toward poetry conceived as a means to an end the other toward poetry as an end in itself focusing on pierre reverdy francis ponge rené char andré du bouchet jacques dupin and marcelin pleynet as the modern french poets who most faithfully reflect these directions robert greene's chronological study allows us to follow the two pronged evolution of french poetry since 1910 situating his argument in a detailed historical context and basing it on comparisons with artistic movements and the poets own writings on art and on extended analyses of selected representative poems the author is able to establish a new intellectual historical perspective on contemporary poetry professor greene finds that whereas reverdy char du bouchet and dupin all embrace a conception of poetry as quest as a search for the absolute as the way of beauty or truth ponge and pleynet hold to a view of poetry as *jête* as a celebration of the relative as the play and display of language in action what knits them together he concludes is the way in which each poet sums up his era as a stage in the development of twentieth century french poetry originally published in 1979 the princeton legacy library uses the latest print on demand technology to again make available previously out of print books from the distinguished backlist of princeton university press these editions preserve the original texts of these important books while presenting them in durable paperback and hardcover editions the goal of the princeton legacy library is to vastly increase access to the rich scholarly heritage found in the thousands of books published by princeton university press since its founding in 1905

the study of resistance developed here by dr esther rowlands consists of a fresh interrogation of the notion of resistance discourse here for the first time this detailed study of selected wartime texts produced by francis ponge benjamin péret henri michaux and antonin artaud compiled between 1936 and 1946 presents a specific critique of resistance which investigates the possibility for opposition and subversion to take place without direct allusion to the object of resistance this investigation questions the criteria according to which literature is perceived as being resistant and suggests that historical and political referentiality may be deemed retaliative and reactionary thereby risking replication of the dominant order the relationship between language and power structures is elucidated through allusion to modern theorists michel de certeau michel foucault ross chambers and françoise proust the necessary framework for a study of the poetic voice draws upon aspects of the post structuralist work of jacques derrida and giles deleuze incorporating specific theories expounded by the surrealist leader andré breton the works of the above theorists are foundational to this new critique of poetic discourse which when applied by dr esther rowlands to the wartime works of the four named writers suggests that language itself may be recognised as a locus of resistance this book is designed to be of interest both to undergraduates and to researchers studying surrealism second world wartime literature and critical theory
