potential and backwards attitudes even as the average gamer grows older the medium remains dogged by the same old question when will videogames grow up the gamergate movement lent this question renewed urgency launching attacks on feminists and social justice warriors that have come to be seen as a catalyst for the emergence of the alt right and election of donald trump this book explores how makers of independent and experimental videogames responded to gamergate and its aftermath analysing key titles released between 2015 and 2018 it shows how artgame designers used assets characters and mechanics scavenged from classic franchises like zelda street fighter and sonic the hedgehog to review gaming s history reframe their own biographies and link gaming s growing pains to a broader sense of disorientation disillusionment and decline in american culture

today a multinational video game developer sega was the first to break nintendo s grip on the gaming industry expanding from primarily an arcade game company to become the dominant game console manufacturer in north america a major part of that success came from the hard work and innovation of its subsidiary sega of america who in a little more than a decade wrested the majority market share from nintendo and revolutionized how games were made drawing on interviews with nearly 100 sega alumni this book traces the development of the company revealing previously undocumented areas of game making history including sega s relationship with tonka the creation of its internal studios and major breakthroughs like the sega channel and heat network more than 40 of the company s most influential games are explored in detail

platform filled with high quality games it was also the product of a short sighted corporate vision focused on maintaining nintendo s market share and business model this led the firm to fall from a dominant position during its golden age dubbed by arsenault the renaissance with the nes to the margins of the industry with the nintendo 64 and gamecube consoles arsenault argues that nintendo s conservative business strategies and resistance to innovation during the snes years explain its market defeat by sony s playstation extending the notion of platform to include the marketing forces that shape and constrain creative work arsenault draws not only on game studies and histories but on game magazines boxes manuals and advertisements to identify the technological discourses and business models that formed nintendo s super power he also describes the cultural changes in video games during the 1990s that slowly eroded the love of gamer enthusiasts for the snes as the nintendo generation matured finally he chronicles the many technological changes that occurred through the snes s lifetime including full motion video cd rom storage and the shift to 3d graphics because of the snes platform s architecture arsenault explains nintendo resisted these changes and continued to focus on traditional gameplay genres

long before it took the home video game console market by storm sega was already an arcade powerhouse parlaying its dominance in coin operated machines into the home video game boom of the 1980s the japan based company soon expanded with branches in europe and the u s and continues to lead the gaming industry in design and quality drawing on interviews with former developers and hundreds of documents this history follows the rise of sega from its electromechanical machines of the mid 1960s to the acquisition of gremlin industries to its 2003 merger with sammy corporation sixty two of sega s most popular and groundbreaking games are explored
